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APPLICABLE REGULATION FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF TRAINING LANES ON THE GRANDE MOTTE GLACIER SUMMER & AUTUMN 2020



COVID 19: TO PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS, PLEASE COMPLY WITH THE CURRENT SANITARY MEASURES.

1 AREA COVERED BY THE REGULATION

These regulations apply as soon as one has rented a specific site on Tignes ski area (Grande Motte glacier or other pistes).

2 TARIFF

The cost of one site for 2020 has been set at 20 euros/day
A specific scale of charges applies to Speed Training Sessions (Downhill and super-G) = 850 euros/day

3 BOOKING CONDITIONS

- Bookings will be open from 20 June to 02 August and from 17 October to beginning of December 2020, according to snow conditions and opening dates of the ski area.
- The bookings are expected by postal mail, at least one week before arrival, with a cheque for payment of the booking, payable to Régie de Recettes des Pistes de Tignes, and with a 150 euros additional deposit, on club letterhead, and signed by the coach responsible for the group on the site. The coach has to specify the coach contact numbers in Tignes, the number of competitors, their level and their speciality (i.e. slalom, giant slalom, freestyle, snowboarding etc).
- In case of lane booking by e-mail, payment has to occur at the same time by credit card over the phone (central + 33 4 79 06 32 00) or by bank transfer for the full amount due. The 150 euros additional deposit will be paid on arrival in Tignes.

Bookings are only confirmed on receipt of payment, and not taken into account without.

For foreign teams unable to pay by cheque, payment must be made on arrival, at the latest by the first day of training.

- The Ski Patrol office, located at La Marlière in Tignes Le Lac, will be open to the coaches every day from 2 to 5 pm, except Saturdays and Sundays from 20 June to 2 August 2020.
- **Last-minute booking and placement:** the ski patrol office will inform the patrollers responsible on the glacier. **Payment has to be made at the latest the first day of training. If it is not the case, training will be stopped.**
- In the event of an absence without cancellation at Central des Pistes (+33 4 79 06 32 00), or of an unjustified cancellation, **the deposit of 150 euros will be cashed.** Otherwise, this deposit will be refunded at the end of the training period.
- Keep the ski patrol office informed (+33 4 79 06 32 00) in case of date changes, so that the lane can be allocated to another team. **If not, the deposit of 150 euros will be cashed.**
- There will be **NO REFUNDS**, even in case of bad weather conditions. Unused days may be carried over to a future date, **within the same year.** Any days unused on a reserved lane cannot be carried over to next year.
- Tignes ski patrol has the discretion to close the training lanes for safety reasons, and to allow the cancellation of bookings three days before the arrival of the team, and to reimburse the booking and additional deposit.

4 PROCEDURAL ORGANISATION ON THE GLACIER

- The piste patrols in charge of race areas, the regional controller and his deputies are the contact points for trainers on the glacier, they represent the Régie des Pistes on the ground.
- There will no longer be a checklist for teams at the entrance to the Funicular in the morning; this will instead be done on arrival up on the glacier.
- Trainers must make reservations with the person responsible for the training area by SMS to the following number only: + 33 6 56 79 87 06. Two choices of training piste must be selected from the following: Rosolin, Champagny, 3500, la Face. All requests must be sent before 11 a.m for a reservation the following day. Confirmation of the training piste allocation will be sent by SMS before 3pm the same day.
In absence of a request by SMS, training lane allocation will be given by the piste patrol on arrival at the top of the training area.

Under no circumstances may a trainer start to place his gates before being shown exactly where they are to be placed, in order to maximise the number of lanes within the race area.

In case of non respect of the place allocated, the **deposit of 150 euros will be cashed.**

Lanes which have not been used by 9:30 a.m. will be allocated to another team.

- Lane modifications will be considered according to availability. If, however, you want to change your designated lane, you must talk directly with the patroller responsible on the glacier, not at the Ski Patrol office.

▪ In the event that the maximum number of bookings have already been registered for the lanes allocated for training, a proposition will be made to the teams to use the lanes later in the afternoon. Lifts will remain open later in autumn.

▪ **The use of the pistes reserved for speed training is governed by an agreement signed between the Régie des Pistes and the training body or team using them.** A procedure for supervision must be drawn up and submitted before any training session. It must set out the planned training methods and designate the principal individuals responsible for the session. The use of the training area by **another team or training body is allowed in the afternoons, under FFS agreement and responsibility.**

Only one high speed racing lane will be allowed per race area for competitions.

Training on the downhill lane during holidays of All Saint's day and all weekends of November is not allowed.

⇒ **Sharing lanes:**

▪ The snow conditions and security rules could require that several teams share the same lane to fill it, and that bookings could be cancelled in case of very bad weather conditions. When more than one slalom course is to be laid out in the same race area, it is the responsibility of trainers to ensure that the race lanes and starts are sufficiently far apart to avoid any collision between competitors.

▪ The Régie des Pistes will restrict freestyle teams training moguls in the race area to the lanes reserved for mogul ski training (max 4 lanes).

Failure to comply with this restriction will lead to the additional deposit for 150 euros being cashed.

5 ACCESS TO GLACIER AUTUMN

Process: "SERVICE PLUS: Funicular for coaches"

A funicular "for coaches" is scheduled every day 15 minutes before the first one accessible to athletes and customers.

Prerequisite: Having booked up a training lane at the REGIE DES PISTES DE TIGNES

Terms of access:

- Having a training lane booked at LA REGIE DES PISTES DE TIGNES, allocation of training by ski patroller at bottom of Funicular.
- The STGM will provide you with a maximum of two armbands "Priorité Remontées Mécaniques" in return for a 100 euros deposit per armband. The deposit can be a cheque payable to STGM and/or cash and/or credit card. The deposit will be refunded when the armbands are returned to the STGM Grande Motte lift pass office control team.
- The armbands give the coaches access to the priority lanes on the glacier. Under no circumstances can armbands be used by athletes.

Nota bene:

- If you lose the armbands, the deposit will not be refunded
- If you keep the armband after the training period, the deposit will not be refunded
- Any fraud will lead to non-refund of the deposit.

Poles transport:

For your comfort, STGM provides you, for free, a pedestrian pass for the funicular in order to bring up the poles the day before your training period. You can obtain the pedestrian pass at the Grande Motte front office.

Except in the Funicular for coaches, it is forbidden to transport poles in the funicular before 9.30 am so that our customers are not penalized.

We advise you to avoid bringing poles down in the funicular between 12.00 and 2.30 pm.

In case of any particular problem, delay of opening due to the weather forecast or technical issue, the pole transportation will only be possible with the agreement of the funicular manager.

In no case, can poles be stored at the funicular bottom station.

Distribution of armbands at STGM Grande Motte lift pass office:

Opening hours: from 7.30 until 8 AM every day.

Restitution of armbands and deposits after the training period, at the same place, opening hours according to display.

The closing hour depends on the season, information at the STGM (+33 4 79 06 60 00)

In case of non-compliance with these regulations, coaches will be refused access to the funicular for coaches and may have their armband confiscated, the deposit will be cashed. In case of non return or loss of the armband, the STGM deposit will be cashed.

6 SECURITY AND MAINTENANCE

▪ Each coach is responsible for the enforcement of all safety rules within the lanes they have been assigned. All ski area regulations and the municipal bylaws relative to safety in the ski area must be respected and enforced.

Training sessions and competitions in these areas take place under the responsibility of the trainers and/or the organising bodies. It is their duty before each training session or competition to ensure that the lanes are made safe for both competitors and people not involved.

▪ **Slopes open to the public are strictly forbidden for training use.**

▪ Slalom courses are out of bounds to people not taking part in training and/or competitions.

▪ The public will be notified of this by means of suitable signs or banners and/or other measures to prevent those not taking part in training and/or competitions from entering (netting, marker tape, elastics, snow barriers ...). Responsibility for setting up these measures will fall to the person(s) managing the dedicated area or to its user(s).

▪ **It is forbidden for security reasons to move any slope markers, signs or any kind of safety devices from their original placement.**

▪ **To allow for efficient grooming of the lanes, it is essential to gather all gates at the end of training each day and put them in the 'Parcs à jalons', delimited zones at the top of the lane.**

▪ To maintain the condition of the site, you must clear your lane and bring down any broken gates and your group's rubbish.

If these rules are not followed correctly, the additional deposit of 150 euros will be cashed.

7 GATE STORAGE

- We suggest that you regularly check the weather forecast: If access to the site is uncertain, you may need to take your gates down in advance.
- We will not arrange a vehicle to recover equipment left on the glacier.
- In case of a storm, one trip on the funicular will be arranged for you to bring your gates down.

8 USE OF THE LIFTS

Lifts must be used in compliance with police regulations. **For safety reasons, it is forbidden to get on or get off the lift midway.** If you do not respect these rules, you will be refused access. **Strict measures including the withdrawal of ski passes will be imposed in case of non-compliance with the regulations.**

⇒ Funicular

Rowdy behaviour when using the funicular is not acceptable. For safety reasons, pushing and running on the platforms of the funicular station are forbidden. Anyone breaching these regulations will be banned from using the funicular.

⇒ Maintenance passageways on the ski lifts

Only coaches with armbands will be allowed to use these passageways. Should it be considered necessary, strict measures including the withdrawal of lift passes will be imposed in case of non-compliance with the regulations.

⇒ Skipass

We inform you, that you are obliged to have your ski pass on you all the time. You must be in a position to present your pass to any member of the lift company staff who requests it.

9 ADVERTISING

- Public advertising on the glacier is forbidden. Only with permission from the mayor is advertising for major events allowed.

We hope you have excellent training conditions on the "Grande Motte".

These regulations are put in place in order to improve conditions for everybody.
