



Several winters ago, Tignes launched their free novice ski areas and progress zones. The idea is simple. Novice skiers can enjoy the opportunity to gently discover the sport in designated safe areas with free access to certain lifts: the magic carpets in Val Claret, Tignes le Lac and Tignes 1800 and the drag lift at Brévières. Progress can then be made on longer runs using a choice of free chairlifts: the Bollin in Val Claret and the Almes and Rosset in Tignes Le Lac. In total, Tignes boasts 9 free lifts.

10 PEAKS CLIMBED, 4 TO GO

In 2021, aged 19, Alasdair McKenzie - a local by adoption and **an ambassador for Tignes** - swapped his downhill skis to embark on a mad mountaineering challenge: to climb the **14 highest peaks in the world,**

all over 8,000 metres. If he succeeds, Alasdair will be the youngest person in the world to achieve such a feat. «At age 17, I convinced myself of the possibility, so we launched the project.»

Alasdair's name already appears in the Guinness Book of Records as the youngest person to have climbed Lhotse. Located in the Himalayas, this peak is the fourth highest in the world, standing at 8,516 metres. A determined young man, climbing

his way to success, he scaled Everest on 16th May


WINTER ART CAMP MADE IN TIGNES!

From 9th to 16th March 2024


The Mountain Shaker adds to its artistic character by putting the artist Lucas

Freeride World Tour Qualifier – 1* 9th March 2024

This FFS competition, expected to be an intensely spectacular event, can be seen from the legendary Lac de Tignes. The 'full moon' freeride runs are the highlight of the event and will provide riders with the opportunity to ski floodlit corridors at night.

SKI SLOPESTYLE WORLD CUP

14th and 16th March 2024 The world's best freestyle skiers compete in Tignes

Tignes, home of freestyle skiing and major international events (1992 Albertville Olympics, Winter X Games Europe from 2010 to 2013...), is set to host a Slopestyle Ski World Cup. The 'Double M' track, featuring 6 modules with 3 rails and 3 tables, is the chosen venue. Top skiers from around the world will compete to link Big Air and Slopestyle, increasing their chances of a podium finish and scoring points in the overall rankings. According to the Norwegian Birk Rudd, 2022 Olympic Big Air Champion, 2023 Slopestyle World Champion and longtime fan of the resort «Tignes is the most beautiful place in the Alps and this is a fantastic event».

INDOOR SKATEBOARDING: FISE XPERIENCE SERIES

12th and 13th March 2024.

The FISE Xperience - first stage of the national tour - is due to take place in Tignes this coming March. On this occasion, French and foreign skateboarders will compete on the 500m indoor skatepark at Tignespace. During the summer, the park hosted FISE riders for the Savoie Mont Blanc Freestyle Tour. According to **Francis** Guichardot, head of the FISE Xperience Series, «Tignes enjoys being part of a programme that highlights other disciplines in the freestyle culture.» Alongside the professional men's and women's competitions, amateur and junior events attract the crowds in the run-up to the professional finals. 

A former engineer, Bastien Gelinotte gave up everything to pursue life in the mountains...

Sport has always been a part of Bastien's life. After 15 years cycling and skiing in the Vosges he continued to compete until he graduated as an energy engineer in 2021. When he relocated to the Grenoble area, his passion for the mountains grew and he discovered the joys of working in the great outdoors. He developed an interest in mountaineering and considered pursuing a career.

According to Bastien, «The mountains are an inexhaustible source of adventure and emotion».

In 2021, after finishing his degree in engineering, he embarked on a 3-year training course to become a mountain guide at ENSA (National School of Skiing and Mountaineering). He is due to complete the course in 2024 and although very versatile, he admits to preferring winter activities such as **ice climbing** and ski touring. This winter, **at just 26 years of age**, Bastien will be spending his first season with the mountain guides in Tignes as a young graduate guide.

ECOLOGICAL TRANSITION

In the aim to become a 100% eco-responsible resort by 2030, Tignes is now concentrating on a number of different initiatives. The resort is determined to reduce its carbon footprint through innovative mobility solutions.

Examples include the creation of a car-sharing community, a free shuttle bus service for seasonal workers and holidaymakers, the launch of the **GoTignes.net** website and the use of electric scooters and bicycles in the summer months...
