To celebrate the start of the season in style, the resort boasts a weekend of festive, sporty entertainment starting on Saturday morning with the distribution of hot drinks at the foot of the Grande Motte glacier followed by an original concert in the evening.

On Sunday, test your skill and endurance in the famous Yeti Race, a fun team challenge combining trail running and obstacle course (distance: 10 km, vertical: +350 m).

The occasion is also a chance for visitors to follow in the footsteps of our Olympic medalists during the first day of the renowned "Etoiles du Sport" event - a 4-day event that attracts the French sporting elite.

6-Seater chairlift - Le Marais

After the Aiguille Rouge chairlift in 2022, Tignes continues to modernise its ski lift network. Le Marais, a new detachable 6-seater chairlift, will carry its first skiers in December 2024. Equipped with "Directdrive" technology, it is quieter, faster and more energy efficient, with a capacity of 2,020 skiers per hour.

Departure point, next to the Aiguille Rouge chairlift. Arrival point, at the summit of the Aiguille Percée.

UNFAILING COMMITMENT

The H+ campaign confirms the resort's commitment to inclusive accessibility for all. This initiative includes the introduction of packages for People with Reduced Mobility (PRM) including dedicated services to facilitate their stay and the assurance that every event promotes accessibility.

Disability Day, to raise awareness on the inclusivity of visitors with disabilities in mountain resorts, is due to take place in Tignes on 3rd December 2024. The event, backed by the Region AURA, echoes the International Day for the Disabled. On the programme: introductory courses, screenings of inspiring films/documentaries and expert conferences on the topic of inclusivity. By working together, we can make the mountains accessible to all.

For over 30 years, in collaboration with the French Ski Federation and the AURA Region, Tignes has been a loyal partner of the French Parasport Federation, enabling disabled athletes to benefit from optimum training conditions. Among them are Lou Braz-Dagand (3rd in the 2023 Para World Cup in Veysonnaz) and Oscar Burnham (3rd in the 2023 Para Alpine Skiing World Championships), high-level Paralympic athletes, both members of the Tignes Sports Club.


Actions are better than words

LOOKING AHEAD TO 2030 AND 2050

Tignes is accelerating its energy, environmental and social transition. The resort, which aims to become a fully sustainable territory by 2030, boasts **4 fundamental policies**, divided into 20 objectives and 92 concrete actions.

- → To promote multi-season, responsible tourism, focused on the La Grande Motte glacier transition project.
- → To maintain year-round living.
- → To preserve natural heritage.
- → To reduce the carbon footprint.

Recent measures taken by the resort include the installation of 40 new electric vehicle charging points and the introduction of ultra-fast charging stations in all sectors of Tignes. The Société des Téléphériques de la Grande Motte now boasts two electric shuttle buses and runs its entire fleet on hydrotreated vegetable oil (HVO), a biofuel that reduces greenhouse gas emissions by 80%! Zero waste

THE STRENGTH OF THE COLLECTIVE!

At the beginning of 2024, the local council, the Régie des pistes, the Société des Téléphériques de Grande Motte and Tignes Développement jointly signed the national charter "Montagne zéro déchet sauvage en 2030".

This collective objective aims to eradicate uncontrolled pollution in the mountains within 7 years, thereby contributing to a global effort to purify the water cycle. This ambitious initiative, launched by the association Mountain Riders, boasts two major measures: the introduction of recycling bins in the streets of Tignes and "Tchao mégots", a campaign to collect, clean and recycle and transform cigarette butts into insulation for construction or textile upholstery.

This commitment is fully in line with the resort's global transition strategy, a **Flocon Vert** destination since 2022.

How to reduce your carbon footprint when skiing?

In order to ensure a sustainable future for alpine tourism and to contribute, when possible, to its preservation, there are a few simple individual measures that snow sports enthusiasts can take to reduce their carbon footprint:

- → avoid travelling by plane or car and travel by train/public transport.
- → heat accommodation to a maximum of 19°C during the day and 17°C at night.
- → favour a vegan/vegetarian diet.
- → rent equipment.



The future begins today

FOR THE CHILDREN OF TIGNES

In September 2024, the young elected members of the Children's Council in Tignes will plant a time capsule, equipped with a GPS beacon, in the bowels of the Grande Sassière glacier. The aim of the experiment is to follow the evolution of the glacier over a 10-year period. This scientific and educational project aspires to raise awareness on global warming in the area and to study the glacier melt. Residents are invited to place a message of hope in the capsule (a drawing, poem or text). See you in 2034!

Live data

Two time-lapse cameras have been installed on the La Grande Motte glacier to help collect data, monitor the impact of global warming on the ice melt and provide food for thought on the evolution and adaptation of water resources in the future.



Tess Ledeux left her mark last winter, winning on home soil ahead of long-time rival **Mathilde Gremaud**.






FRENCH FREERIDE SERIES



11TH & 12TH MARCH 2025



In addition to the professional men's and women's competitions, amateur and junior events will take place prior to the professional finals.




